On or about June 25, 2009, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 192(b), a Felony, was committed by CONRAD ROBERT MURRAY, who did unlawfully, and without malice, kill MICHAEL JOSEPH JACKSON, a human being, in the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony; and in the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful manner, and without due caution and circumspection.

Dissemination of a SCAR is limited by Penal Code §§ 11167 and 11167.5 and a court order is required for full disclosure of the contents of a SCAR.

Further, attached hereto and incorporated herein are official reports and documents of a law enforcement agency which the undersigned believes establish probable cause for the arrest of defendant(s) CONRAD ROBERT MURRAY for the above-listed crimes. Wherefore, a warrant of arrest is requested for .
